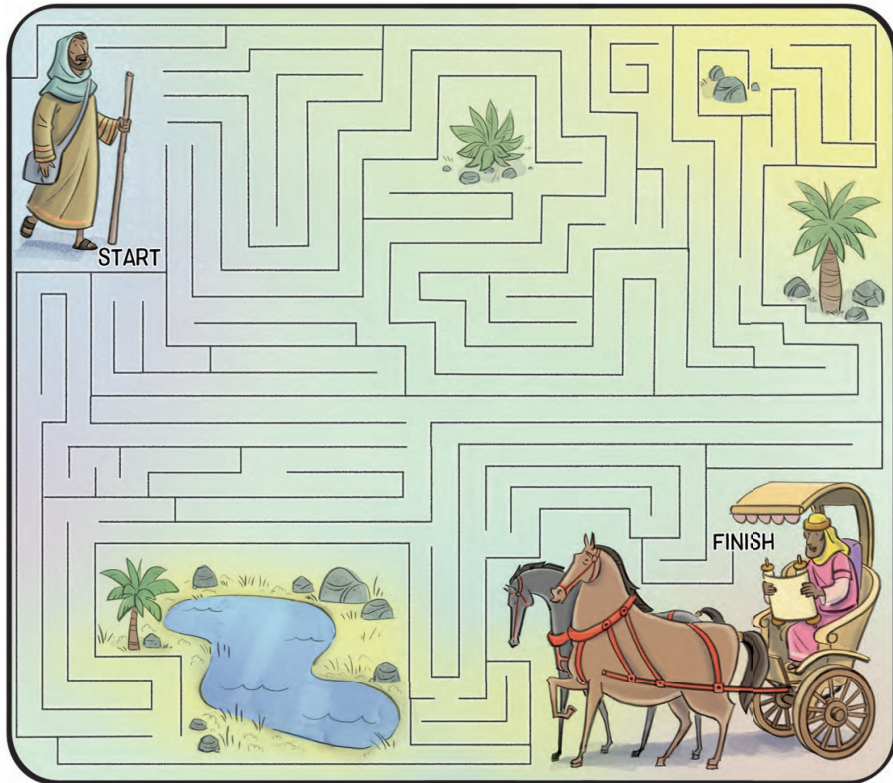


MAZE
