

Jesus is GREATER than our ability to understand who He is

Read each passage of scripture and sketch a picture of what is happening in those verses.

Mark 8:1-10 Jesus performs a miracle by feeding 4,000 people with a couple loaves of bread and a few fish.

Mark 8:11-13 Even though Jesus had performed many miracles, the Pharisees demanded a sign to prove that He is God the Son.

Mark 8:14-21 Jesus is with the Disciples in a boat, but they don't are confused.

Mark 8:22-26 Jesus healed a blind man in stages.

Can you see what Jesus was trying to do when He healed the blind man? It may help if you think of it like this:

- The blind man (at the beginning when he could see nothing) was like the Pharisees. Even though they had seen all that Jesus had done, they couldn't see (or understand) that He was God the Son.
- The blind man (when he could see some things but not clearly - people looked like trees) was like the Disciples. They sort of knew who Jesus was but they couldn't see (or understand) clearly.

When we are confused about what the Bible is saying, we don't have to worry because Jesus is GREATER. He will patiently help us to understand.
