

H.E.A.R. is a simple Bible Study method that you may find helpful

HIGHLIGHT

After reading the passage of Scripture, HIGHLIGHT a verse or two in the passage that speaks to you. Write this verse in your journal.

EXPLAIN

EXPLAIN what the verse means. With the help of God’s Spirit, you can understand the meaning of it. Ask simple questions of the verse like:

- How does it fit with the verses before and after it?
- Why did the Holy Spirit include this passage in the book? What is He intending to communicate?
- Write out what you think it means.

APPLY

Answer these questions to uncover the significance of these verses to you personally.

- What does this mean today?
- What would the application of this verse look like in my life?
- What is God saying to me?

RESPOND

Based on these verses, what is God calling you to do? Your response may take on many forms. Here are some examples:

- Write a call to action.
- Describe how you will be different because of what God has said to you through His Word.
- Indicate what you are going to do because of what you have learned.
- Write out a prayer.
